Session 3 - Interactive session I: Identification of Impacts

In this interactive case study, participants will work in smaller working groups with the aim to identify the likely impacts associated with the Option 1 and 2 presented in the Case Study for Sessions 3&5. The Case Study is based on Draft Impact Assessment of the "Regulation for the Design of a Functioning Integrated Administration and Control System (IACS) [for farmers support schemes] and a Land Parcel Identification System (LPIS) in Turkey".

Tasks:

- 1. Read the whole Case Study Worksheet individually to familiarize yourself with the issue and prepare for the group assignment. (10 mins)
- 2. Work on below exercise in your group. (50 mins)
- 3. Present your results to the other groups and participate in discussions (all groups). (5 mins)

Exercise:

Based on the case study material participants are asked to discuss and prepare the following questions and issues:

- 1. What are the likely impacts (economic, social, environmental)?
- 2. Who is affected?
- 3. Are the impacts positive or negative?
- 4. How significant are the impacts?
- 5. Over what time period do the impacts occur?
- 6. Is there any distributional effect among impacts?
- 7. Identify impact on specific sectors/categories of stakeholders. i.e. competition, SMEs
