

Session 4 – Interactive session: Measuring and Analyzing Impacts

In this interactive case study, participants will work in smaller working groups with the aim to identify, measure and analyze impacts associated with the Options presented in the Case Study for Session 4. The Case Study is based on Impact Assessment of the “Regulation for the Design of a Functioning Integrated Administration and Control System (IACS) [for farmers support schemes] and a Land Parcel Identification System (LPIS) in Turkey”.

Tasks:

1. Read the additional data for the case study and exercise below individually and prepare for the group assignment (10 mins).
2. Work on below exercise in your group (60 mins).
3. Present your results to the other groups and participate in discussions (all groups).

Exercise:

Based on the case study material and previous interactive sessions, participants are asked to discuss and prepare the following questions and issues:

1. Identify benefits and costs for each option
2. Consider the time value of impacts
3. Quantify as many benefits and costs as possible
4. Calculate Net Benefits
5. List other impacts (costs and benefits) that could not be quantified
6. Compare options and recommend one option
